## Dear Parent/Guardian:

Your son or daughter has been invited to participate in the Adolescent/Teen Health Program presented by the <u>Family Resource Centers of Northeastern Nevada</u>: The program will be offered at the <u>Elko County Library: West Wendover</u> at 590 Camper Dr.

The program uses evidence-based, medically accurate curricula that is all about teaching youth how to make proud, responsible decisions about their body and future. Students will be introduced to a variety of subjects, including pregnancy prevention and sexually transmitted diseases (STDs) including HIV/AIDS, as well as, handling peer pressure, and how to utilize learned negotiation skills for difficult decision making. Your child will be involved in a variety of learning experiences, including small group discussion, films/video, and games designed to teach youth about different health problems. Your child will be asked to participate in a survey that will help to evaluate the efforts of the program among youth in Nevada. Participants will be asked to take a survey, at the beginning of the program and immediately after the program. The survey will ask about things such as knowledge about HIV/AIDS, future educational aspirations and health behaviors such as sexual behavior (if applicable). **Confidentiality:** The records of the survey will be kept private. Since the survey will ask only for gender and age, it is not possible to identify participants by name. No one will know what your child reports, as they will be instructed to not include their names and other identifying information on the surveys.
