

2020 GENERAL ELECTION

IMPORTANT DATES

October

October 6, 2020	Last day to register to vote by mail, an agency, field registrars, or in person
October 7-15, 2020	NOVA Online Registration and updates on the Secretary of State's Website
October 16-29, 2020	NOVA Online Registration and updates considered same-day registration, voters must appear in person with government issued ID. If residential address is different from what is on ID, proof of residential address is required.
October 17-30, 2020	Early Voting at the Elko Convention Center 8:00 am to 6:00 pm M-F 10:00 am to 2:00 pm Saturdays
October 27, 2020	Last day to request a replacement mail ballot

November

November 3, 2020 **GENERAL ELECTION from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm**

In-Person ballots must be delivered by the closing of the polls on Election Day to the Clerk's Office or ballot drop boxes.

Ballots sent via USPS must be postmarked by November 3, 2020, and received by the Elko County Clerk's Office by 5:00 p.m. the 7th day after Election Day in order to be processed.

2020 GENERAL ELECTION INFORMATION

Pursuant to AB 4 that was passed during the 32nd Special Legislative Session, all active registered voters will be sent a mail ballot, but the **seven regular polling locations will be available for in-person voting on Election Day**. This gives voters the choice to either vote by mail or in person.

The Clerk's Office is working closely with the United States Postal Service to ensure the timely delivery of the mail ballots.

If you choose to vote in person, you may bring your mail ballot to surrender to the election workers at the polling place or, if you do not bring your mail ballot, you must sign a Certificate for New Ballot prior to voting.

You may also drop off your mail ballot at the Clerk's office, during **Early Voting** or any Election Day polling location. **Drop boxes** will also be available at the Carlin, Wells and West Wendover City Clerk's Offices during their normal business hours from October 19 through October 29, 2020.

Voters are required to wear a face mask or face shield when voting in person pursuant to the Governor's directive. If you cannot wear a face covering for medical reasons, please bring proof so that we may accommodate your needs. Please be aware that there may be long lines at the polling locations because the check-in process will be longer. All polling locations will be in compliance with social distancing requirements and all election equipment will be sanitized between voters to reduce the risk of spreading the COVID-19 coronavirus.

The Clerk's Office is receiving a high number of inquiries regarding third-party mailings notifying voters that they may not be registered to vote. Please note these notices are not coming from the Clerk's Office. Voters are encouraged to verify their voter registration information by calling the Clerk's Office at (775) 753-4600, by email at election@elkocountynv.net or online at <https://www.nvsos.gov/votersearch>.
