



ELKO COUNTY COVID-19 CASE UPDATE – 2/4/2021 TWO ADDITIONAL COVID-19 DEATH REPORTS

Elko County is reporting two additional deaths today. Both individuals were Carlin residents, a male in his 80s and a male in his 60s. We extend our heartfelt sympathies to the family, friends, and caregivers who have lost loved ones.

Elko County is reporting 11 new cases and 10 recoveries. Thirteen cases are currently hospitalized.
