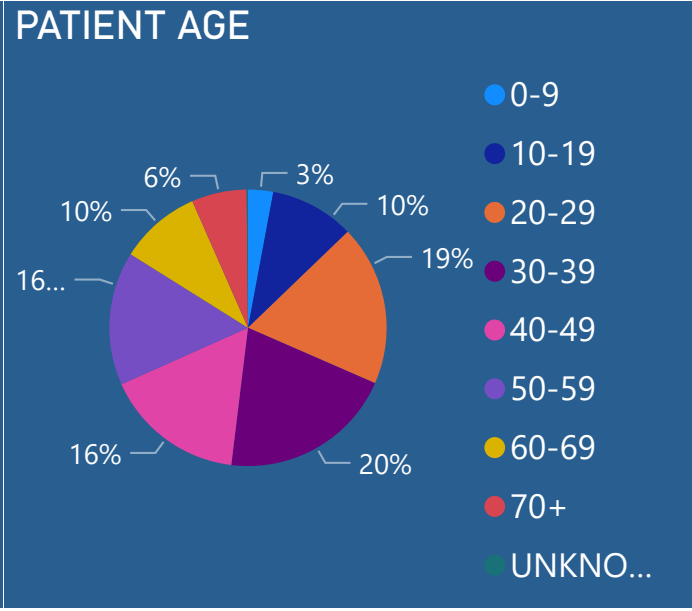
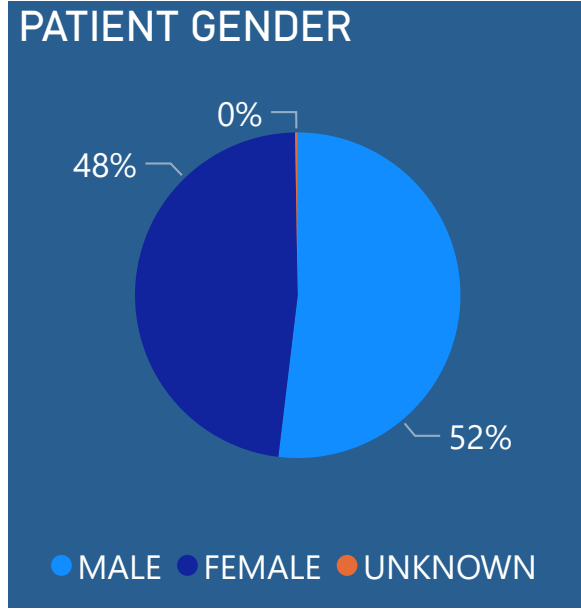

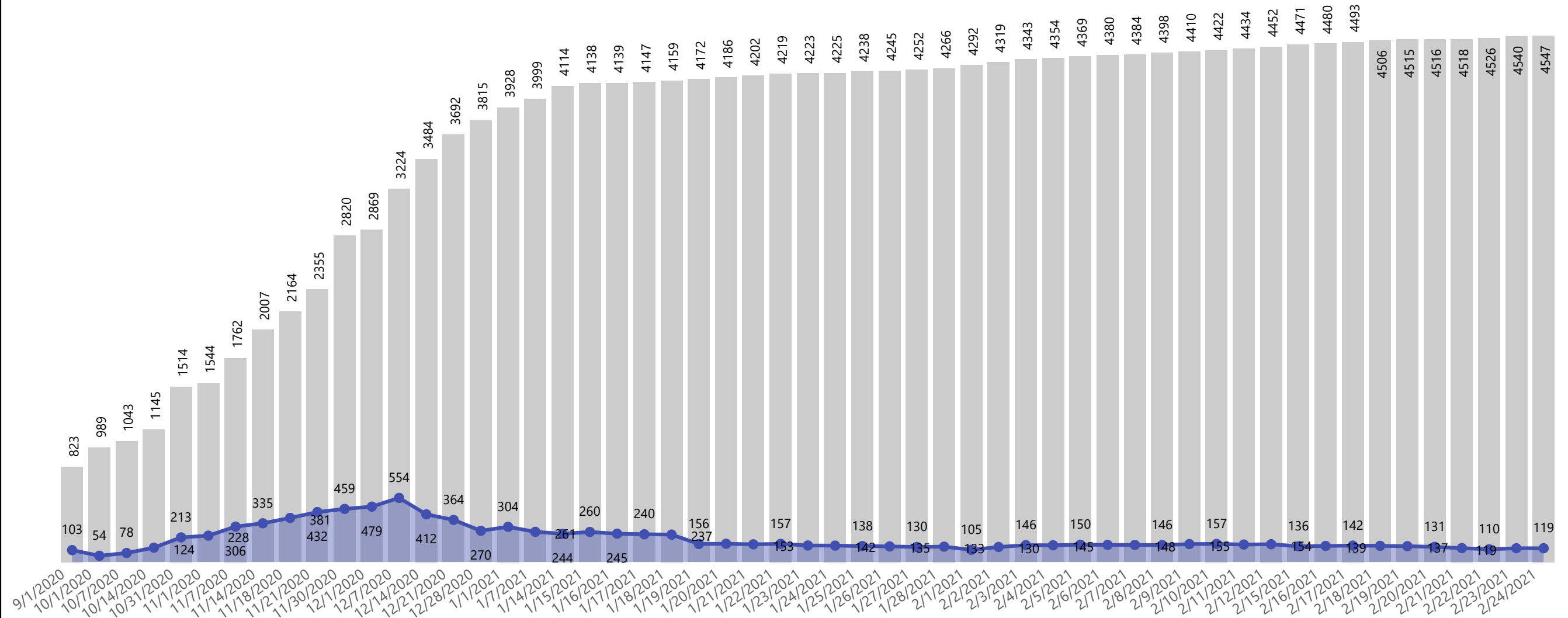

### **ELKO COUNTY COVID-19 CASE UPDATE – 2/24/2021**

Elko County is reporting 7 new cases and 7 recoveries. Twelve cases are currently hospitalized.

The breakdown of total confirmed cases is as follows:

- 4,547 confirmed cases
- 119 active cases
  - 12 active case(s) hospitalized
- 4,377 recovered cases
- 51 deaths
