City of West Wendover City of Wendover 4th of July 2024 Parade Rules

Theme: "We Are America"



- 1. *The parade will line up* on N. Gene L. Jones Way (in front of the West Wendover City Hall) beginning at 10:30 am Wednesday, July 4th.
- 2. *If you are late* getting to the line up area, you will not be allowed in the parade and will have to park you entry until the parade has finished. **BE EARLY!**
- 3. *Parade will start promptly at 11:00 am* and proceed East to the Wendover, Utah Fire Station (9th Street), Wendover, Utah. Floats will exit on 9th Street.
- 4. Safety of Participants and Spectators are of the up-most importance.
- 5. *Participants must obey these rules* of the Police and Parade officials at all times. Refusal to do so will result in your immediate withdrawal from the parade.
- 6. *The West Wendover Police Chief* will assume complete authority over the parade and its operation.
- 7. *No Alcoholic Beverages* will be allowed in the parade.
- 8. *Horses* shall stay in a group and be controlled by the riders.
- 9. *Motorized vehicles* will not show any exhibitionist driving, i.e. brodies, spinning of tires or any actions determined by the Police Chief as dangerous to the public. Police will act in their fullest authority of the Law to stop any such actions.
- 10. *To prevent crowd injuries*, nothing can be thrown from any unit in the parade unless such unit is within 15 feet of the curb area. Walkers or slowly driven ATV's may be driven within 15 feet of the curb and toss candy to the curbside. Motorized vehicles must use extreme caution at all times to prevent injuries to spectators.

- 11. *Units that shoot water*: Any shooting of water directly into the crowd or participants is prohibited. Person in charge of any such unit shooting water is held liable for any and all actions by the unit.
- 12. *Unlicensed or underage drivers:* The parade route is a special event and allows unlicensed or underage drivers to participate. The adult will be held legally liable for any and all actions of the unlicensed or underage driver. It is still illegal to drive these vehicles on public streets to reach the parade staging site and return to the home base of the float. All unlicensed or underage drivers must be transported by trailer or truck to starting area and picked up at the end of the parade route on 9th Street, Wendover, Utah.
- 13. *Dancing groups*: Due to the size of the parade and the time involved, the parade will not stop for dancing. Dancing can be performed while walking. No Exceptions. All dance groups will be separated by one float.
- 14. *Emergency Vehicles*: If an emergency response is called, the parade will be stopped and the appropriate agency will pull out of the parade and as safely as possible respond to the incident. The parade will remain stopped until the responding units have cleared the parade area. When an alarm is paged, all emergency units not responding to the alarm will stop, turn out their lights and sirens, and wait for the responding units to clear the parade.

Judging Parade Entries And Special Recognition Awards

- 1. Judging will take place during the parade.
- 2. In order to be judged, you must have completed an entry form and be registered with the City for the parade.
- 3. Entrants are not eligible to receive more than one award.
- 4. All entries are eligible for the following Special Recognition Awards:
 - Overall 1st place based on concept, colors and design
 - Independence Day Parade Pride, First Place Trophy. This 3 foot trophy will be engraved each year with the name of that year's winner and be displayed to the public at the West Wendover City Hall along with a photograph of the winning entry. Additionally the first place entry will receive a \$200 cash prize.
 - All entries will receive a participation award
